Changes in the 2012 Legislative Session resulted in the Governor's Office of Elderly Affairs, Elderly Protective Services Program to be merged with the Department of Health and Hospitals, Office of Aging and Adult Services as of June 25, 2012. There will not be a change in phone numbers, office locations or staff. EPS staff will continue to receive reports, conduct investigation and interact with their community and resources.
