



The New Orleans Health Department & New Orleans Medical Reserve Corps is conducting a Community Assessment for Public Health Emergency Response (CASPER) on **Saturday, June 28th from 9am-4pm**, to gauge the readiness of elderly citizens within Orleans Parish to prepare for and respond to an emergency. This event will include door to door outreach to the homes of 140 elderly residents that have durable medical equipment or are on dialysis.

We are looking for volunteers to help us conduct this door to door outreach. At each home, volunteers will collect information from each resident by asking a list of survey questions and then provide the resident with a go-kit that contains information and supplies to prepare for hurricane season. The information collected during this event will be analyzed and used to plan outreach events for neighborhoods within the parish.
